

CURRENTLY

Boulder H and I is still going into 5 facilities. The Adams County men's meeting had to cut back to one meeting a month because they didn't have enough support. Boulder County men's meeting is doing well and they are hoping to get a few more people so that they can have a meeting three times a month. The panel would like to talk to the facility about having an NA meeting outside of the Phoenix program. The women's meetings in the jails are going well and they meet at both jails once a month. At Boulder County the women are still going into two pods at the same time, if they have enough chairs to split into two meetings. However, they could also use some support so this split happens more regularly. The ARC is in desperate need of support. There are currently only two people serving on the panel, and they are responsible for taking meetings in every week. Centennial Peaks is going well and all chair spots are filled, the panel coordinator also has a decent sized back-up list.

IN THE WORKS

The Broomfield County Jail Meeting is still in the process of phasing into the facility. The facility is requiring 5 years off paper. The H and I committee decided to keep clean time aligned with the rest of the jails, so 1 year clean time is required. The meeting is looking to start on Thursday, August 1st at 7pm. It will be held one time a month, women and men will be at the same time but at different locations in the jail. The meetings are not mixed gender meetings. A panel coordinator was elected in March and since that time 10 people (5 women and 5 men) have stepped up to serve as panel members.


