I'm Dan B and I'm very grateful to humbly be of service

Groups in our area

South Side Survivors is carrying the message as usual. The group is meeting its financial obligations and currently offers 16 meetings per week.

Peace of Freedom Group in Alamosa reported they are holding 3 meetings a week and are meeting their financial obligations. He also reports that they are following traditions to the best of their ability. The group is having an average of about 9 addicts per meeting. They had 10 newcomers in the last month.

The Common Thread group has informed the SCANA that they have started a new meeting at a different location. I'm not sure at the moment of the exact location and times but I'm happy to report that SCANA is adding the new meeting to the area meeting list.

CRCNA Fundraiser

The 1st annual southern area CRCNA fundraiser "Parking it in Recovery" at the Pueblo City Park was in my humble opinion a smashing success. The event kicked off around 10am and conclude around 5pm. We took away from the park some valuable experience that will serve us well in the years to come. The Frisbee golf tournament didn't draw much of a crowd but we had a real great time with pie in the eye and the water balloon fight was a blast. It's also my sincere pleasure to say that we actually raised some funds. I don't have the exact number today or a check to present but sometime in the near future the Southern area will be giving the CRCNA committee more than \$600.
