DOC Coordinator Report

We had a great turn out for the DOC training at CRCNA XXVIII. We had 25 applications of volunteers that were cleared to train and 16 attended the training at the convention. We had 48 volunteers that were contacted to complete their annual updated training and 23 attended the updated training at CRCNA. So we have a total of 64 volunteers that are cleared to carry the message of Narcotics Anonymous into the Department of Corrections facilities.

I want to update you on the current DOC meetings that we have and approximately the numbers of addicts behind the walls that are attending. We will start with Arkansas Valley with approximate attendance from 10-15 addicts, Camp George West attendance of 15-18 addicts, Delta Correctional Facility- 25 addicts, Denver Women's- 30-50 addicts, LaVista Women's allow 12 at a time, Sterling East side 20-25, Sterling West side- approximately 25 between the medium and maximum pods. We have started two more facilities this year- Rifle Correctional and Four Mile in Canon City. They each have approximately 20-25 in attendance on a regular basis. We have grown tremendously over the past 5 years and I am honored to have been able to participate in this growth. I believe that the Relationship between DOC and Narcotics Anonymous has expanded with the Trainings that take place annually at CRCNA and the live call that we have on Sunday morning that connects the addicts behind the walls with our fellowship. We had all 9 facilities connected plus we had Trinidad on the line even though we currently do not have a meeting there. They really want and need us to carry a message to their facility. I have been recently contacted by the volunteer coordinator at Fremont Correctional Facility in Canon City as they too want an NA meeting at their facility. We still need volunteers in the Southern Area.

So this brings me to my next request. I really could use some volunteers to help me keep the DOC meetings running smoothly in each facility. I currently have panel coordinators for Denver Women's, Camp George West, LaVista Women's, and Four Mile. We need help for Sterling, Delta, Rifle, and the expansion going into Canon City, which is where the majority of our correctional facilities are. We are in the process of adding some of these positions to the Regional H&I Guidelines. There are also changes concerning the CRCNA Guidelines pertaining to the DOC Training and the Sunday morning DOC connection call that need to be added.

Now I would like to touch on the literature that the Region has given DOC over this past year. We started with 100 Basic Texts (approximately \$1100) that were approved in January with some of the revenue from CRCNA XXVII. At that time all of the facilities received 10 books each with the exception of Denver Women's given 15 and Sterling which were given 20. These books

are given to the individual addicts that attend the meetings on a regular basis. I also received 40 books (approximately \$500) over the course of the year 15 went to Four Mile and 15 went to Rifle to start those meetings. I was also blessed by a Mile High Area home group- Saturday Night Live- that supplied H&I with 50 Basic Texts and 50 Step working guides. I gave each DOC facility 5 Step working guides and 5 Basic Texts, which was between June and August of this year. It seems like there is always a need and we were grateful for the extra literature we received.

I realize that we will never have the amount of literature that are needed in the DOC facilities, as we just do not have the resources. I would like to ask for more literature in January when the revenue from CRCNA XXVIII is available. We are currently serving 9 facilities with the hopes of adding 2 more in 2015. Even if we only give them 20 books each throughout the upcoming year, we will need 220 books (approximately \$2000). Then I would like to send a set of each of the books to the facilities we do not go into so they can have them in their library and this is a total of 13 facilities. If we send them a Basic Text, It Works How and Why, Step Working Guide, Just For Today and a Living Clean, that would be a total of 65 books (approximately \$600).

I want to say that it is an honor and a privilege to serve the Colorado Region and the addicts behind the walls. It's just getting too big for me to continue organizing by myself. It has taken a while for me to realize this and I humbly ask for your help.
