

1. The City of Broomfield has put three Narcan distribution boxes at their courthouse, Health and Human service office, and Library. I have made efforts to get lit racks at those sights, or our flyer if not a lit rack. I called Ester at the library and haven't heard back from her. I called the health & human services office. They got back to me and asked me to send an email

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with the flyer and a photo of the lit rack so they can make a decision about which option they're comfortable hosting for us.

2. I printed 250 meeting lists. They offered me a 50% off coupon, so I increased the number of copies to accommodate the extras needed for Literature rack restocking. The cost was \$73.52. I paid out of my own pocket and will need to be reimbursed.
3. I have restocked the lit rack at the methadone clinic. They have relocated it to their room that hosts group meetings, so I think it'll get heavily picked.
4. I have restocked the lit rack at the Public Defender's office. It didn't get much use.
5. I restocked the IPs in the Boulder County Jail lobby. It was nearly empty. Fortunately, H&I goes there often so we'll keep it well stocked.
6. I restocked the IPs at the Crisis Center. Unfortunately, their use has decreased since their move. Grace works there so we'll know when it gets low in inventory.
7. I have restocked the lit rack at the Refuge Café in Broomfield. They took the IPs out of the Lit Rack and put them in individual IP holders. I took the lit rack and am hoping to use it for the Narcan distribution boxes.
