Activities:

1. The City of Broomfield has passed on our request to host a literature rack at their Narcan distribution box at the Health and Human service office. They were, however, willing to talk with the municipal court and detention center to see if they'd host the racks. She said she'd advocate for us and have them reach out to me with their decision, which hasn't had the time to happen yet, so I'll report on that next month.
2. I still haven't heard back from the library about their Narcan Distribution box, so I called them a second time. Still no reply
3. I restocked the lit rack at the Triangle Club. That rack is present and available at all operating times of the recovery club, not during just Clean for Today meetings, so it should fall under the umbrella of PI. It was almost entirely depleted and took a large portion of my inventory.
4. Someone at CU reached out to us to host a booth at their health fair sometime in April. I expressed interest in doing so and told them I'd need more information. I have not heard back from her.
5. I printed 200 meeting lists. My printer at home was acting wonky, so I had to email a copy to them to print. They offered to print the 200. I expressed concerns that it would be more expensive. She assured me that it wouldn't be so I agreed. The total for all 200 was \$52.26. I think she only charged for a single sided copy. I paid out of my own pocket and will need to be reimbursed.
6. I changed the address for the New Beginnings meeting in Longmont. They




